Hong Kong ArtWalk

A Academy of Visual Arts of Baptist University – street performances by students

B Cédric Maridet – ‘Huangpu’, music and video, 20’28 mins duration

Location: Experimenta, small lane at entrance of 1 Mee Lun Street, Central

This mesmerizing video and subtle music piece by Hong Kong-based artist Cédric Maridet depicts a barge slowly traveling along the Huangpu River near Shanghai; the original sound of the video is used to create the composed music.

E Kwan Sheung Chi – ArtWalk 2009 'Artist-in-Residence'

In 1980, KWAN Sheung Chi was born in Hong Kong. In 1999 he entered the Fine Arts Department of the Chinese University of Hong Kong. In 2000 he was named the King of Hong Kong New Artists. In 2002, the 'Kwan Sheung Chi Touring Series Exhibitions, Hong Kong' was exhibited and toured in ten major exhibition venues in Hong Kong; also, the Hong Kong Arts Centre presented 'A Retrospective of Kwan Sheung Chi'. In 2003 he graduated with a bachelor degree from the Fine Arts Department of the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
